Festival will help fund Daniel's Den Playground

A harvest festival to benefit the Daniel's Den Playground project will be held from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Oct. 27 at Clipper Magazine offices, Hempland and Donnerville roads.

Misty Young and Jodi Carpenter, organizers of the event, report that festival features include a chicken barbecue, silent auction, a variety of games, children's craft tent, baked goods and yard sale tables and live entertainment.

Admission is free, and all of the day's proceeds benefit Daniel's Den Playground. The playground is a 501 (c) (3) not-for-profit venture and is a project of the Harrisburg-based Foundation for Enhancing Communities.

Volunteers are busy raising \$375,000 and are enlisting 1,000 volunteers for "build week" at Manor Church south of Mountville, April 22-27, 2008.

The playground is unique to Lancaster County because it is designed for use by all children, particularly those with disabilities and physical limitations.
